LIMESCALE - Limestone is present in all coastal areas. As rain water passes through it, it dissolves adding calcium carbonate ions to the water, resulting hard water. When subjected to changes in temperature and pressure, hard water forms crystals which become solid as aragonite, better known as limescale.

Valencia is the hard water capital of Spain, and limescale (cal) is a big problem blocking pipes, damaging pumps and washing machines and water heaters.

The traditional domestic solution is a large water filter costing over 1200 euros, which needs to be topped up with salt every few months to keep it working. When all else fails, an expensive chemical treatment is required break down the limescale - not very ecological.

LIMESCALE PREVENTION WITH HYDROPATH - Hydropath technology is the low cost, long lasting solution. Hydropath uses electronic pulses to prevent limescale forming and to break it down if it already exists. Hydropath creates a field of positive electrons on the skin of the pipes throughout the water system that prevents the limescale forming (The Skin Effect). Seed crystals are formed as the water passes through the energy field. Microscopic Calcite crystals form and these pass through the system, leaving the piping and electrical appliances unaffected.

Below Dr Stefanini, the brains behind Hydropath, demonstrates with an oscilloscope how Hydropath works throughout a water system. The unit in the demonstration is the HydroFLOW HS38, which is used in homes throughout Europe. The radio frequency waves travel forwards and BACKWARDS through the pipes, which can be conductive or non-conductive. HydroFLOW works 24-7 whether the water is flowing or not. All other anti-limescale products ONLY function when the water is switched on and flowing - ie some 4% of the time in a house or flat.

CORROSION, BACTERIA & ALGAE - HydroFLOW technology has the added benefit of attacking corrosion, bacteria & algae. Products have been designed specially for swimming pools and aquariums - AquaCLEAR; and for agricultural use - AgriFLOW; and for oil wells! - clearWELL.

HydroFLOW has products for Office Blocks and Hotels and Factories - the C Range.

Houses and Flats are served by the HydroFLOW HS range - HS-38 is the current model.

HydroFLOW is subject to worldwide patents and you can only get this technology from approved Hydropath distributors, such as CalNuncaMas, who brought Hydropath technology to Valencia for the first time in 2009.

BACKGROUND TO CALNUNCAMAS - In our work in property management, we have come across problems with limescale numerous times. We were suggested the electronic solution by a client in one of our flats, who had once been a distributor for Scalewatcher, the Dutch supplier. We looked at Scalewatcher and did our research - we heard many favourable reports; The Scalewatcher uses a wrap around cable to energise the water. But this only really works, when there is the water is flowing. Also the costs and the fact that their Small Wonder is made in China were not encouraging.

It was the editor's comment in plumbersworld that "in their opinion, HydroFLOW was the best", that led us to the UK's Hydropath, who are responsible for Hydroflow.

All Hydropath products are made in England and subject to computerised testing and have a 3 year warranty.
